Workshops are for students and advisors!

- **September 21, 2010 (Tuesday) – Early Registration Deadline! Advisor Orientation from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM at the Metropolitan District Commission Training Facility in Hartford, CT**

*Enjoy good food and exchange ideas with fellow educators and environmental professionals. You'll leave prepared and energized for the program year ahead!*

- **October 2, 2010 (Saturday) – Fresh and Saltwater Estuaries Workshop from 8:30 PM to 1:00 PM at UConn Avery Point Campus and Bluff Point in Groton**

*Development and increased population have resulted in the loss of coastal and inland wetlands, and eelgrass beds in the shallow, near-shore areas. These habitats provide a unique and highly productive ecosystem that supports an array of living resources. Take a hike to Bluff Point and learn why our tidal wetlands are so important to the health of Long Island Sound.*

- **October 23, 2010 (Saturday) – Forestry Workshop from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM at Tolland County Agricultural Center in Vernon**

*Work with forestry professionals to discover this truly renewable resource. Develop skills to better identify and understand our forests environmental and commercial values. Learn to read the story the forest tells!*
